

### MORE THAN WE CAN ASK OR THINK

What an amazing God we serve! Despite a culture that continues to careen to everincreasing levels of dysfunction and opposition to the Christian faith in many ways and places, what Jesus promised 2,000 years ago is still true today: "Now I say to you that you are Peter (which means 'rock'), and upon this rock I will build my church, and all the powers of hell will not conquer it," (Matthew 16:18, NLT).

And we have witnessed Jesus building His Church in powerful ways here at Riverside the past 12 months. In ways that are more than we can ask or think (Ephesians 3:20, NLT), we have watched our incredible Lord do what only He can do among us and through us.

By God's amazing grace we continue to stay focused always on Jesus' mission: to reach people and help them become fully-devoted followers of Jesus Christ. I continue to share this same statement I have made in previous annual reports because it is still so true: While we are a community of people who have spiritually-defective DNA, we also have been and are being transformed, and we are empowered by Jesus to engage in His mission. He has a special delight when we as individuals and as a church embrace and participate in that which is the passion of His great heart: lost people matter to God, and He wants them found.

#### Staying focused on Jesus' mission matters. It matters more than anything else.

And now God has opened a door for us that a year ago seemed closed. In early June 2023, we closed on the former Wright County Health and Human Services building in Buffalo. We have already started the demolition work, and a very aggressive construction plan that, God willing, will allow us to open this 3<sup>rd</sup> campus in March 2024...and hopefully, have Easter services there March 31, 2024! To God be the glory!

We praise the Lord for the faithful giving of Riversiders over the past decade which meant when this door reopened, we were able to take next steps immediately to take advantage of this opportunity. We have been able to purchase this property with cash, and God willing, we will be able to remodel this building with cash! That's no small thing at any time, but especially when economic times are uncertain.

Our challenge now as a church is to give generously and sacrificially to ensure we are able to fully fund the operations/ministries of all 3 campuses in future years, and to rebuild our bank balance so we are ready when God opens the next door for us to pursue. Be sensitive to what God is saying to you about your next step of generosity.

As you read the through the summaries of what has happened the past 12 months, be sure to take a moment to thank and praise God for what He has done through you as part of Riverside. What you have done matters. For the lives changed because you invited, prayed, served, gave, and cared. And remember, every one of those numbers has a name, every name has a story, and every story matters to God. And to us! Celebrate with our ministry leaders as you discover success stories; thank them for their service and continue to pray for them as the new fiscal year begins. Pray for our Elders and leaders as we continue to lead and seek God's will for Riverside.

This means more than two people every day for the past 12 months said 'YES!' to Jesus as Lord through the people and ministries of Riverside (sounds a lot like the first Church in Jerusalem, where we are told that, "And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved," Acts 2:47)! Praise the Lord for His wonderful love and amazing grace!

Thanks to everyone at Riverside who in these past 12 months has prayed for me and my family, encouraged me with a note, an email, a pat on the back, or even a hug. I know I say this every year, but you need to know these things mean more to me than you will ever realize. I am thankful for a godly and mission-focused board of Elders who care so much for our staff and entire church family. Gwen and I are grateful to the Lord for our small group and many others of you who care about us, pray for us, and demonstrate real love to us.

It has been my privilege to serve as your Senior Pastor for almost 20 years (as of September 1), and I look forward to the next 12 months with joy and great anticipation! Together let's continue to be an outward focused church that makes and multiplies passionate followers of Jesus.

Dear Riverside Family.

Riverside Church has never had so many people worshipping every Sunday, serving in ministry, being a part of small groups, engaged in the grace of giving, and taking healthy next steps in its 90+ years of existence. Our in-person worship attendance is closing in on our pre-Covid levels at the Big Lake Campus and is already there at the Sauk Rapids campus. The same is true for our online experience as well. To God be the glory!

As we look back, we see God was faithful - how exciting it has been to witness the NEXT**STEPS** people have taken! We saw new families join us for the first time almost every week. Our Riverside Kids and Riverside Student ministries continued to thrive. God graciously led 124 people to follow Him in baptism. We received 67 new members into our fellowship. Small group participation exceeded 1300 people for the first time. And amazingly, God drew even more people to Himself than last year - praise Him for the 910 people who said "YES!", repenting and trusting Jesus as Lord this past year.

Last year we wrote to you about our disappointment in not getting the Wright County facility in Buffalo. But God opened this door dramatically for us again in November, and in a period of a few months, we had 2 government agencies approve our purchase and use of this building in a fantastic location. And because of your past generosity and careful financial management, we will be able to purchase this building and remodel it without borrowing any money. What a good, powerful, and faithful God we serve!

God accomplished all of this, and to Him alone be the glory. But amazingly, He chooses to involve His followers in His work!

So, if you are in Jesus, your prayers for the people around you matter. Your invitations to "come and sit with me" matter. Your steadfast acts of service and support for the ministries of Riverside matter. And your commitment to become like Jesus - loving others like He loves you, matters most!

# **RIVERSIDE KIDS**

As kids come to Riverside, we want to help them **MEET JESUS** (Experience Grace) through care they experience, knowing there is a safe place for them to learn about Jesus' love. From a volunteer rocking a baby in the Nursery, to helping an anxious toddler feel safe enough to leave mom's side in the Early Childhood area, or coming to understand the forgiveness of a Savior who loves them as they say their own 'YES!' to a relationship with Jesus in the Elementary area. This past year we welcomed **1,720 kids** who had a chance to MEET JESUS through the love and care of over **250 volunteers** who serve on the lower level. God moved in the hearts of **286 kids** who said their own 'YES!' to Jesus.

Kids can grow in their ability to LOVE JESUS AND OTHERS (Grow in Love) as they discover talking to God, hear or read His Word, repeat and memorize verses, and see how to show others kindness. Kids are introduced to small groups of kids the same age, making friends and getting a taste of what it's like to be in relationship with others, seeing how they can each play a part. Through Child Dedications, No Limits, 1st graders and new older kids who've never owned a Bible, over 250 Bibles were given out. Many elementary-

aged kids have been using the reading calendar daily, and as one parent stated, it's been a "game changer" sparking great conversations at their house as they read the verse together each night before bed.

As kids are learning, we want them to experience the joy of what it's like to SHARE JESUS (Give of Yourself) with others. Kids are great inviters so we give them opportunities to invite friends each month to Game Shows as well as Summer Camp, Playdates in the Park, or any Sunday at Riverside Kids. The joy and excitement Worship Crew kids have serving others by leading their peers in worship is contagious. Even though they are young, kids are building foundational truths that will stay with them for a lifetime.

As 1 Timothy 4:12 says,

"DON'T LET ANYONE THINK LESS OF YOU BECAUSE YOU ARE YOUNG. BE AN EXAMPLE TO ALL BELIEVERS IN WHAT YOU SAY, IN THE WAY YOU LIVE, IN YOUR LOVE, YOUR FAITH, AND YOUR PURITY."

# RC GLOBAL

We continue to have a lot to celebrate in missions, including a new partnership and sending teams to multiple partner locations to encourage, support and assist in ministry. God is on the move around the world, and it's awesome to be a part of that work, whether by giving, praying, sending or going. Thank you so much for your faithful giving that enables us to be engaged in these places!

**MEXICO:** We sent one work team in August, another team to serve at their Marriage Encounter weekend in March, as well as another work team in June to help get their new San Sebastian campus more ministry effective. God is working in Mexico and it's been very encouraging to have been a small part of that this year. Our teams have been well received and effective in serving our Project SouthPointe partners in Guadalajara, Mexico.

**GUINEA:** We sent our first team to Guinea this year, and established an official partnership with them that begins July of 2023. This Envision site, even though newly established, is seeing God do some amazing things among the hard soil of the majority religion landscape. Personal relationships drive their ministry, so it's a bit slower moving, but effective. Prayer for the current team and their ministry, as well as for another couple to add in the future would be greatly appreciated.

**BURKINA FASO:** The Arnolds continued their work in reaching the Dogose people as they were able despite security issues which are very much a reality of life in Burkina Faso. God opened doors for effective ministry despite these difficulties with 6 more wells being drilled and 4 more hangars being built. They have been "commuting" back and forth from the US to take on selected hands-on opportunities while engaging long distance through the abilities of modern tech. The Dogose people continue to come to faith, with hundreds more who were lost last year becoming a part of God's family this year! Keep praying for the Good News to spread, even among very difficult circumstances.


