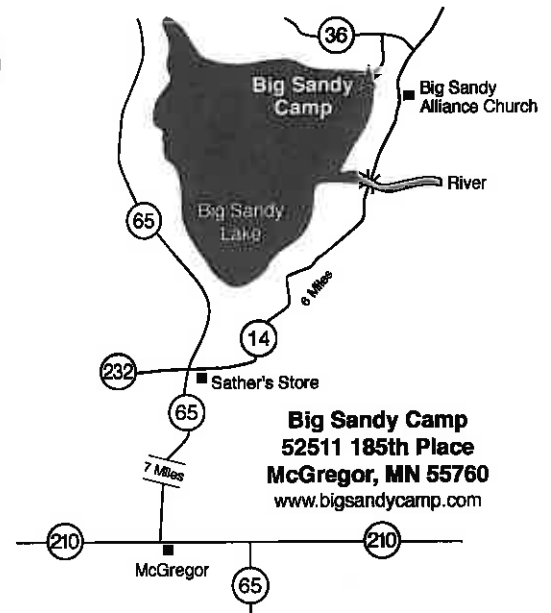
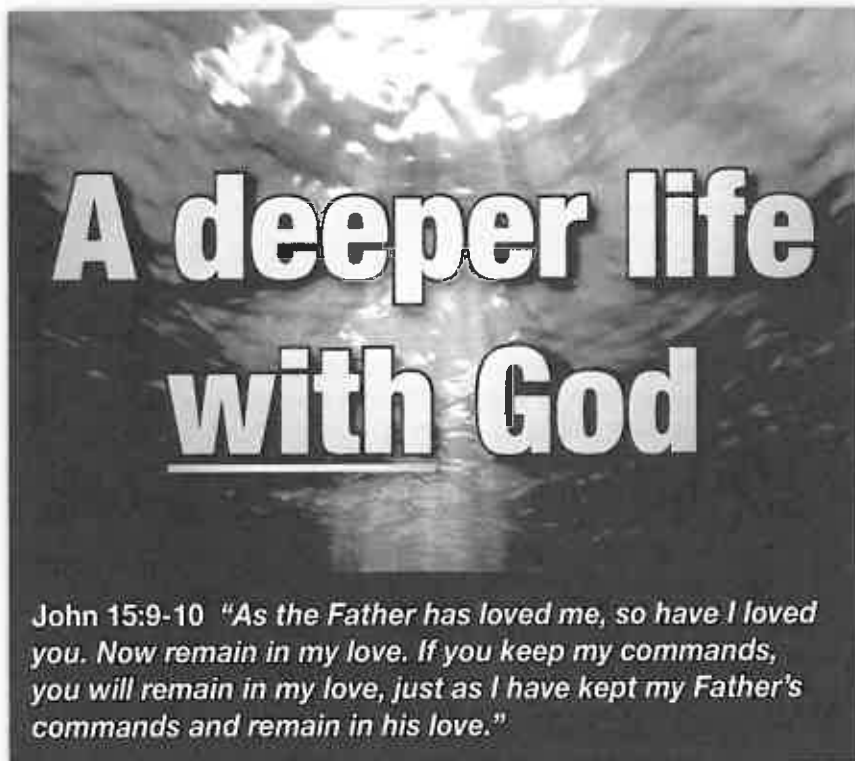


# MEN'S RETREAT 2018

## Retreat Speaker

Kevin Walzak



I grew up in Kinnelon, New Jersey, in a non believing home. I only attended a Church on Easter and Christmas rarely. After a serious injury in a street fight God opened the doors for me to attend a youth group meeting called Campus Life. During that summer I was invited to a summer retreat. It was there at the age of 15 that God opened my eyes to see my need for a savior and that Jesus came and died for me. On that day by faith I received Jesus as my savior and committed my life to Him. From that moment on God has been actively conforming me to the image of His Son. Telling others about Jesus became a natural part of my daily journey.

In 1981 I completed my bachelors degree at the College of New Jersey. That was followed with a Master of Divinity degree at Alliance Theological Seminary and a doctoral degree from Gordon Conwell Theological Seminary in preaching. I have been a pastor for 30 years. I have six children (five girls, one boy), eight grand children, and been married to Linette for 35 years. I have had the privilege to minister for Christ in more than a dozen countries. Most recently in Rwanda East Africa, where I was training 55 high level leaders from several different countries. My wife Linette and I have served full time with three congregations, all with the Christian and Missionary Alliance. The first was 12 years as a church planter in Culpeper, Virginia, followed by seven years at the Syracuse Alliance Church, and finally for the last 11 years at the Alliance Church in Mountain Lake, Minnesota. I am a board member of the world wide movement of the College of Prayer and a member of the Licensing Ordination Consecration Council for the North Central District of the C&MA.

In 1981 I was a Division III national champion in wrestling and qualified for the final Olympic trials in 1980. At the age of 59 I can still bench press 315 pounds and did 109 pushups straight just couple of years ago. I am the inventor of the mango splitter. I love to fish, hunt and play golf, and I have coached high school wrestling and golf for a number of years.

My greatest desire is to have everyone I come into contact with be more in love with Jesus when they leave than they were before we met. I love encouraging men in their walk with Jesus and have personally been involved in leading thousands of people to Christ.
